TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. The Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules and regulations adopted by VIT Expo Inc., hereafter referred to as the International Travel Expo and the Vancouver Wedding Expo will have the final decision in adopting any rule or regulation deemed necessary prior to, during and after the show.
2. The Exhibitor agrees to use the space(s) provided only for the display of products or services specified in this agreement and agrees not to sublet or share the spaces (s) unless written authorization is provided by VIT Expo Inc.
3. All electrical service will be supplied by the Convention Centre and will be at the Exhibitor's expense. The procedures, along with the relevant guidelines, will be provided in the exhibitor kit.
4. The Exhibitor will not hold VIT Expo Inc. and the owner of the Convention Centre responsible for any liabilities arising from any injuries or damages to said Exhibitor, his agents, helpers or employees, or to the property of the said Exhibitor occurring in the buildings or grounds or the approaches and entrances hereto, except by negligence of VIT Expo Inc.
5. An Exhibitor may cancel their booth reservation up to 60 days prior to the show's opening. In such cases, 50% of the booth fee will be refunded, while the remaining 50% will be credited toward participation in the following year's event. Cancellations made within 60 days of the Expo are non-refundable, though 50% of the total payment will still be credited toward next year's event. All cancellations must be formally communicated to VIT Expo Inc., and the effective date of cancellation will be based on the date the notice is received. Once the event has begun and the Exhibitor has started exhibiting, no refunds or credits will be issued.
6. In the event the Exhibitor fails to register by the deadline established for the Expo without prior written authorization, VIT Expo Inc. reserves the right to re-let such space(s) and any payments received will be deemed as liquidated damages and retained.
7. In the event the Exhibitor fails to comply with any terms of this agreement, all rights of the Exhibitor hereunder will cease and terminate. Any payment made by the Exhibitor on account hereof will be retained by VIT Expo Inc. as liquidated damages for breach of this contract and VIT Expo Inc. may hereupon re-let the space.
8. VIT Expo Inc. reserves the right to reject or prohibit any exhibits or exhibitors if, in the organizer's opinion, such actions are necessary to maintain the event's character and maintain good order. In such cases, no refunds will be issued to the exhibitors.
9. The Exhibitor's property will be placed on display and VIT Expo Inc. assumes no responsibility for loss and damage thereto. The Exhibitor will assume all responsibility for loss of damage to his property due to fire, theft, flood, lightning, earthquake, explosion, or any other case beyond the control of VIT Expo Inc.
10. All goods shipped to the Show must be prepaid and clearly marked with the name of the Exhibitor and the number of his space. Goods must not be shipped or arrive before the schedule move in date. VIT Expo Inc. assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to goods before, during or after the Expo.
11. The Exhibitor agrees that no display will be dismantled, or goods removed during the entire run of the Expo and the display will remain intact until the closing hour of the last day of the Expo. The Exhibitor also agrees to remove his exhibit from the Expo premises by the final move out time, or in the event of failure to do so, the Exhibitor agrees to pay for such additional costs that may be incurred. The removal of material from the grounds will not be allowed before move out except where accompanied by "Release Forms" provided by VIT Expo Inc.
12. If the venue is destroyed by fire, natural disaster, or any other circumstances that prevent the VIT Expo Inc. from holding the event, all payments related to booth rentals will be refunded less any administration fees.
13. The Exhibitor is liable for any damages caused to building floors, walls or columns, booth equipment, or to other Exhibitor's property. The Exhibitor may not apply paint, lacquer, adhesive or other coating to building columns and floors or booth equipment.
14. The Exhibitor agrees to always maintain qualified personnel in the display during the Expo hours. VIT Expo Inc. will not assume any responsibility for losses or damages incurred from pilferage or any other causes. Exhibitors should take all possible precautions to protect their own property, including insurance if deemed necessary.
15. Badges will be supplied by VIT EXPO Inc. with only the company/brand name requested.
